



Gilwell 24 2019: Information for parents/guardians

What to expect...

Gilwell 24 is an extremely big event and this may appear daunting when you first arrive on site. The following information will help the smooth arrival of your young persons to the event. The activities start at 21:00 on Friday for a few hours and 9:00 on the Saturday morning. Traffic management will be in operation before those times. The site may appear chaotic and therefore it is important that you follow all directions from our Traffic Management Team.

What you need prior to arrival

Before you arrive with at Gilwell Park please ensure you have the following:

1. Group Leader's name and mobile number
2. Group booking reference (available from your group leader)
3. Details of any meeting point on site

On arrival

On arrival you'll be directed by a member of the Traffic Management team to the drop-off parking zone. Please state clearly that you're dropping off and ensure that you have the relevant event vehicle pass (see below) displayed in the window of your car. This needs to be completed in full, and is available online in the 'Information for all drivers' pack or from your Unit/Group leader.

Please note that the speed limit is **5 mph** within Gilwell Park.

Please read the 'Information for all drivers' pack thoroughly before accessing Gilwell Park. This is available on our website or on request from your Unit/Group leader.

Dropping off

When you reach the drop-off parking zone, there's a strict 15-minute waiting limit in this area. Therefore, you must ensure that you don't leave your vehicle longer than this period. Once parked, you should walk with your young person to the meeting point.

Note: In certain circumstances where vehicles are causing an obstruction or are incorrectly parked, Gilwell Park reserves the right to tow such vehicles out of the way without the owner's express permission.

Meeting point

There's a designated meeting point, located next to Jack Petchey Lodge (Event Arrivals) leading onto the Branchet Field. Please leave your young person with their group leader or nominated contact and then return to your vehicle and depart.



Leaving site

Please be courteous as you leave the site. There will be many young people walking around as they prepare for the weekend. Therefore, please remember the speed limit is 5 mph. A Traffic Management Team will be present – please follow the directions given by them to exit the site.

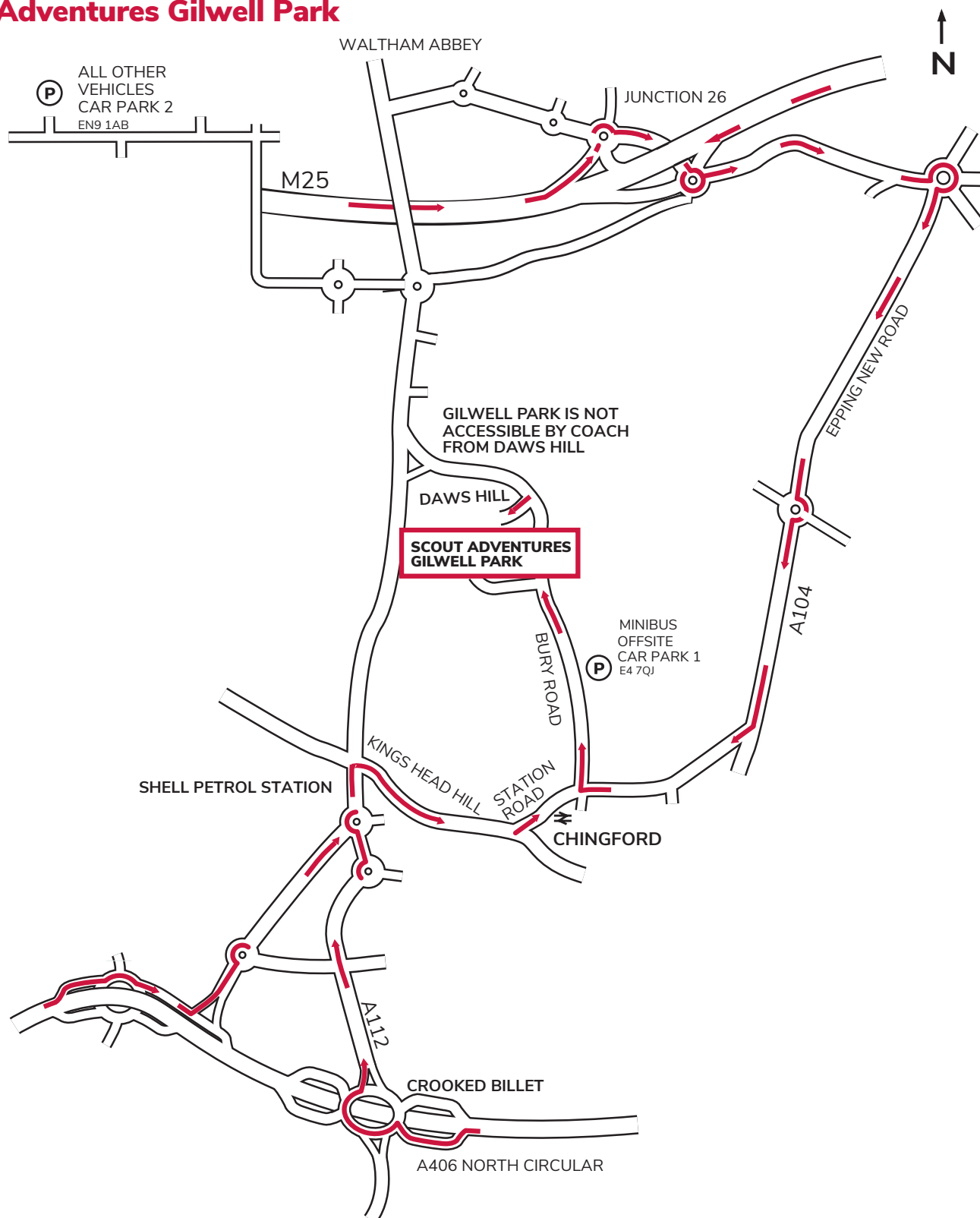
Picking up after the event

Directions to Scout Adventures Gilwell Park



From Junction 26 of the M25 – Eastbound

1. At first roundabout, take 3rd exit for the A121
2. At second roundabout, take 1st exit onto A121 (Westbound M25 from here)
3. At third roundabout take 4th exit onto Epping New Road
4. Turn right onto Rangers Road
5. Turn right onto Bury Road
6. Turn right onto Gilwell Lane
